

## Guidelines for PTA Summer Academic Grant Program

- **To be eligible to apply for the summer grant program, all students must:**
  - **Have a C+ or better grade average**
  - **Be an MPHS student entering grade 9, 10, 11 or 12 in September**
- Teacher, principal, or guidance counselor recommendations may be included or requested by the committee.
- All applications must be emailed to the PTA Scholarship Chair, Liz Panuccio ([Panuccio2005@verizon.net](mailto:Panuccio2005@verizon.net)) no later than **5pm on Monday May 23, 2022**. No applications will be accepted after that date.
- All applications must be **completely** filled out, signed by a parent, and the printed program material (including cost) must be attached.
- Any other grants or scholarships received for attending the program must be noted. Cost to attend the program (travel, airfare) is the responsibility of the student.
- PTA grant funds will be disbursed directly to the program, however if proof of payment by parent is submitted then the check can be issued to the parent.
- The main focus of the summer program should be on the academic activity as indicated on the application. The academic activity should not be a small part of a much larger program.
- The summer program should be related to activities that the student has been involved with in MPHS such as science, math, language, social studies, English, art, or music/drama.
- Leadership camps/programs are eligible, as are certain programs focused on career development.
- **Not eligible:**
  - Sports camps
  - Programs that are offered in connection with established clubs/classes such Take Action (that are already partially subsidized)
- The amount of the grant is at the discretion of the committee.
- The total number of grants awarded is at the discretion of the committee.
- The maximum grant amount is \$500.
